


# LOUNGE ACT

DRUM SET

The drum set notation is written on a single staff with a common time signature (C). The piece begins with a 3-measure rest, followed by a 7-measure rest, and then a 5-measure rest. The first drum set entry starts at measure 8 with a continuous eighth-note pattern. A repeat sign appears at measure 13. At measure 15, there are two measures of a double bar line with a '2' above it, indicating a two-measure rest. The drum set resumes at measure 18. At measure 23, there is another two-measure rest. At measure 28, there are two first endings: the first ending is a 4-measure phrase that leads to a double bar line, and the second ending is a 4-measure phrase that leads to a repeat sign. The drum set continues with the eighth-note pattern through measure 33.


